

## The Backyard Farming Connection Strawberry Growing Guide

**Need to Know:** Strawberries are delicious fruits with compact plants and a high success rate. Strawberries are self pollinating.



**Choose the Best Strawberry Varieties:** select plants based on flavor, productivity, berry size, and seasonality. Hardiness zone 5-8. Strawberry plants fall into 3 seasonal categories:

**Planting:** Plant in raised beds, rows or containers in early spring from bare root or potted plants. Spread roots and plant crown of plant right at soil level. Mulch.

Maintenance: Water frequently and keep plants free of weeds Harvest: Harvest as soon as berries are ripe and cool immediately
