## **Growing Requirements**









6-8 Hours

**12-24** inches

Regular and moderate

pH 6 to 7

**Planting:**Plant outside only after soil has warmed and the last frost date has passed.

Maintenance: Water consistently and keep plants free of weeds.

Consider growing cucumbers on a trellis.

**Harvest**: Harvest when cucmbers are 6-8 inches. Cucumbers grow quickly so check often.

Companion Plants: radishes, marigolds, and

nasturtiums

Avoid Planting With: tomatoes and potatoes

#### **Special Care:**

cucumbers have shallow roots and need consistent water.

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
