


The Backyard Farming Connection Carrot Growing Guide

Need to Know: Carrots are a cool-season vegetable that thrive in loose soil. Carrots take a long time to germinate so be patience and weed during this time.



Planting: Early spring or late summer for a fall crop

Maintenance: Pay attention to weeds and weed frequently. Thin plants to 2-4 inches

Harvest: Harvest at 70-80 days. Take care not to damage roots and remove carrot tops to store.

Companion Plants: onions, radishes, marigolds,	Special Care: Thin
lettuce, chives	carrots to maintain
Avoid Planting With: Dill, potatoes, tomatoes	carrot size and flavor.
